A professionally applied glaze adds another layer of beauty to your Schrock cabinets. First, a craftsman applies a wood toner, which accentuates the grain's natural attributes. Then the glaze is applied, creating an enhanced look with depth, dimension and an understated sheen.

Because our handcrafted glazes are designed to make every cabinet unique, you can expect the effect to range from a consistent, even appearance to varied coverage on a single door and from one door to the next. You should anticipate the end result to yield a subtle to dramatic look based on the complexity of a cabinet door's design, as glaze may collect in the corners and grooves. Requesting a sample door in your chosen style, finish and glaze option is an important step in the order process to help ensure your satisfaction.
